



THE FELLOWSHIP NEEDS YOU!

S.L.A.A. Fellowship-Wide Services is actively working on a new book, *The Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions of S.L.A.A.* The book will provide tools and support for S.L.A.A. members to get sober, stay sober and live in recovery, and will give S.L.A.A. meetings a basis for studying the Steps and Traditions as they apply in S.L.A.A. We need your written experience, strength and hope. Our goal is to represent the full range of S.L.A.A. experience with the Steps and Traditions. *Your share is important.*

The book will be based on ***Sharing Sheets*** submitted by members of the Fellowship world wide. Sharing Sheets are simply short writings on one specific Step or Tradition, discussing your understanding of it, how to work it, or your personal experiences of having worked it.

This is literally a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for each of us to help fellow addicts for decades to come. Here are four suggested ways you can contribute:

1. **The Hard Drive Drive.** At some time in the past, you may have made notes for a lead on a Step or Tradition, or written something at your sponsor's direction to show that you understand and have worked a Step. *Search your hard drive for your notes from that lead or assignment.* Draft a sharing sheet from those materials.
2. **Start An Email Circle.** Pick six or eight friends in recovery. Choose a Step or Tradition. Set a deadline (say, two weeks). One by one, members write on the Step or Tradition, sharing their write-ups with each others in the circle. The leader submits each write-up as a sharing sheet after their deadline.
3. **Participate As a Meeting.** *Encourage your meeting to hold a writing session once a month during the meeting time, or to hold a one-hour writing workshop after the meeting.* Pick a Step or Tradition, have a couple of members give 5-minute leads on the Step or Tradition, and start writing!
4. **Sponsor a Writing Workshop.** *Help Intergroup to set up a half-day or full-day writing workshop.* Sydney Intergroup's representative for this project, Peter D, can be contacted at 12and12@slaa.org.au.
