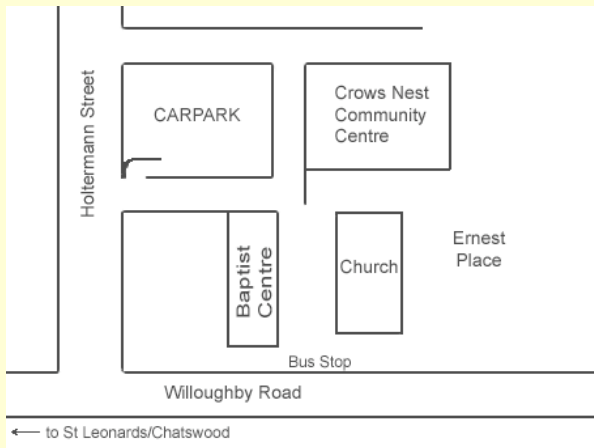


Accommodation?
